

**NEW CT SCANNER, SUSQUEHANNA HEALTH  
WILLIAMSPORT, PENNSYLVANIA**



The renovation for the new CT scanner involved the conversion of an existing x-ray file room. An adjacent control room was also redesigned to accommodate two control consoles for separate CT scanners. The existing spaces, the construction budget, and the project schedule were all very limited, and required a tailored design process emphasizing a close coordination with the staff of the department. The design includes recessed fluorescent cove lighting fixtures and recessed incandescent downlights which provide a comfortable setting for the patients and flexible lighting for the staff operating the scanner.

Despite the aggressive schedule and limited time for design and construction documents, the project bids all came in under the budget. No change orders to the construction contract were necessary for the renovation project.
