

**MEADOWS PSYCHIATRIC CLINIC,
CENTRE HALL, PENNSYLVANIA**



The Meadows Psychiatric Center is a 110 bed intermediate care psychiatric clinic located in a completely rural setting of Potter Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania. To insure a non-institutional appearance of the facility as requested by the owners, six separate buildings (designed with residential style sloped roofs and natural exterior materials of field stone and wood horizontal siding) are situated in a campus plan with connecting walkways and plazas and extensive clusters of trees and landscaping.

Five of the buildings provide segregation of treatment areas for children, adolescents, young adults, older adults, and substance abuse patients. The sixth building contains allied therapy facilities with a gymnasium, lockers, arts and crafts, music, classrooms for school age patients, central dining for patients and staff with full service kitchen, and administrative offices.
