

FERGUSON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

The Ferguson Township Municipal Building houses public tax collection, engineering and administration offices plus a public meeting room. The building has many passive solar features including heat reflective glass and earth berms. Additional buildings designed for the road and maintenance departments are located adjacent to the main municipal building. These buildings are situated around a central staging area. The earth berm technique is used around the perimeter of the staging area to hide the vehicular operations from the view of adjacent residential neighbors. This building includes all necessary facilities to accommodate all of the functions of the township police force plus emergency services activities.
