The Bryce Jordan Center has 360,000 square feet of gross floor area and seats 15,500 persons for basketball games. The Center is a multipurpose facility and, in addition to intercollegiate athletics, is designed to accommodate a wide variety of other events including conventions, circus, exhibits, graduation ceremonies, and theatre stage shows. The Center also houses athletic administrative offices, athletic coaches offices, a "Founders Society" lounge area and The Athletic Development Nittany Lion Club Offices.

The main seating bowl is reinforced concrete with a steel truss roof structure. It is 90 feet clear from the finished event floor to the underside of the 350 feet clearspan steel roof trusses.

Professional design services for the Center were provided by a Joint Venture composed of **Haas Building Solutions** of State College, Pennsylvania; Rosser International Inc. of Atlanta, Georgia; and Brinjac Kambic Associates Inc. of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.
